

CATTLE

Exhibitors with entries to the value of £5 or over will be entitled to 1 free Exhibitor's Pass.

Entries must state Registered Name, Herd Book Number and Date of Birth in respect of each animal on the Entry Form.

Cattle Passports

All Cattle must be accompanied to and from the Show by their passport duly completed. The correct Holding Number (CPH) for the Showground must be used.

Brucellosis

Great Britain is Officially Brucellosis Free (OBF). Cattle under temporary Defra restrictions and recently imported cattle undergoing testing in isolation to reach OBF status will not be accepted.

NORMAL FULL TERM CALVINGS

Animals which calve or show evidence of being about to calve whilst at the showground must be placed in the approved isolation accommodation, pending their possible early removal from the showground.

Where an animal calves at full term, the animal may return to the show lines, at the discretion of the Show Veterinary surgeon, ONLY IF the owner has arranged for a blood sample and a vaginal swab to be taken and examined at an approved laboratory, and both the ELISA blood test and microscopical examination of the smear have proved negative.

ABORTIONS AND PREMATURE CALVINGS

Where an animal CALVES PREMATURELY or ABORTS, the local DVM must be informed immediately. The animal must be placed in the approved isolation under BS27 restrictions and the full range of required samples taken. The animal will not be allowed to take further part in the Show and, once it is fit to travel, can be returned home to the registered premises or alternatively retained until the end of the Show in isolation and returned with the other competing cattle from the same premises.

No other cattle from the same registered premises will be allowed to compete further in the Show until negative test results have been received. They can be returned with the suspect animal at the end of the Show.

Enzootic Bovine Leucosis (EBL)

Great Britain is Officially EBL Free. Entries will not be accepted from herds within which EBL is suspected, or of cattle undergoing a period of post-import isolation.

PERPETUAL SILVER CHALLENGE CUP

This Cup is awarded to the Exhibitor who gains the most points in Cattle Classes on the basis of 4 points for a 1st prize, 3 points for a 2nd prize, 2 points for a 3rd prize, and 1 point for a 4th prize, where such prizes are awarded.

In the event of any class with only ONE EXHIBITOR, POINTS WILL BE LIMITED TO FOUR. In the event of a tie, the exhibitor winning the most 1st prizes will be awarded the Cup.
